About School of Public Administration:

The School of Public Administration at Renmin University of China (RUC) is a leading institution of public administration education in the People's Republic of China. It consists of 3 academic departments (public administration, urban planning and management, and land and real estate management) offering undergraduate degrees and 7 institutes (Institute of Education, of Public Policy and Public Safety, of Social Security, of Organization and Human Resources, of Public Finance, of Quantitative Analysis in Public Administration, of Non-Profit Organization) offering graduate degrees. The areas of concentration include but are not limited to: Public Administration, Land & Real Estate Management, Real Estate Economics, Urban Planning and Management, Educational Law, Educational Economics and Management, Educational Administration, Higher Education Studies, Regional Economics, Urban Economics, Public Policy, Social Security, Social Medicine and Health Management, Public Organization and Human Resources, Labor Economics (Human Resources direction), and Public Finance Management. The School is host of a national-level postdoctoral research station, and the Secretariat of National MPA Education Steering Committee.



About IMPA Degree Program at Renmin

The International Master of Public Administration and Policy Degree (IMPAP) is designed for English speaking individuals who are interested in more in-depth understanding of China's governance, its public policy, its reform, and its future administrative prospects. The degree program will also enable a career network that can help enhancing international students' career opportunities in China and China related jobs in other areas of the world. The Program in RUC is a platform for international students to learn about China's governance, its past lessons and experiences in administrative reform and public policy, and its future prospects. It is an opportunity for this group of people to come together to discuss the China they know, and enhance their understanding of China beyond the level of superficial empirical experiences. The



academic strengths of Renmin's School of Public Administration and its social and administrative embeddedness gave the School a unique edge in providing education to students who are interested in learning about China's administrative reform, in cultivating talents for China's future governance, and in engaging the international community to learn about and participate in China's further development. We welcome international friends as well as individuals from Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan to our program.

Eligibility for Application

English-speaking individuals interested in China's development from around the world

Admission Criteria

A Bachelor's degree or above;
Preferably a full-time work experience of two years or longer;
English proficiency (TOFEL or Other Ministry of Education Approved English tests taken within three years at time of application. Language tests are waived for native speakers or non-native English speakers who obtained a college degree from an English speaking country when the language of instruction is English);
Finishing RUC IMPA online application and submitting required supporting materials.
The Academic Qualification Committee organized by RUC will review the application materials. An interview (teleconference interview possible) will be granted to those whose application qualifications are approved by the committee. No written examination is needed.

Application Materials:

1. Application Form. Complete Online Application on the website of the Graduate School, RUC (click "Online Application for Master Programs in English" on <http://pgs.ruc.edu.cn/> to register), then print out the completed Application Form.
 2. A Personal Statement (study plan should be discussed)
 3. Copies of Passport, Academic Transcripts, Diplomas and Certificates (originals need to be provided for validation)
 4. Two Letters of recommendation
 5. Four recent 2-inch photos
 6. Sample copies of published articles, awards, or other research outputs (if applicable).
 7. Non-refundable application fee of 600 CNY
- Please read the overall English Programs' information on the University Website to find out how to pay the application fee. DO NOT send cash or check inside your application materials.
8. Other relevant materials

Applicants from non-English speaking countries are required to provide English test certificates such as TOEFL or IELTS or other proofs acknowledged by the Academic Qualification Committee at RUC.

Fees

After admission, an annual tuition of 60,000 RMB should be paid at the beginning of each academic year. The tuition does not include Board and Room, Books, Medical and Insurance, Practicum, and other personal expenditures. Room charges will be approximately 6 to 13 dollars a day on campus depending on the quality of the residential halls.

A rough estimate of other costs include:

Health Insurance: RMB 600 per year

Incidental expenses (discretionary)

About RMB 800yuan (per year) is a reasonable amount to budget for textbooks and other study-related expenses, such as printing and stationery supplies.

Living expenses monthly

Food: RMB 1,200

Campus Housing (for international students):

RMB 31-35/day for double room, sharing bathroom;

RMB 80-90/day for single room, private bathroom;

Off campus housing: the rent varies from RMB 2,000 to 4,500 per month.
